Program Overview

Camp Wabansi is seeking enthusiastic teens who are passionate about camp, kids, and the great outdoors to play an important role at Camp Wabansi for the camp season. The Assistant Counselor (AC) program is a volunteer opportunity open to teens ages 16 & 17 only. AC's will bridge the gap between Junior Counselors and staff by performing a variety of camp functions including but not limited to:

- Planning and leading all-camp activities
- Assisting counselors with trips out of camp
- Assisting with cabin group activities
- Helping with minimal custodial duties around camp
- Aiding in activity setup and cleanup

Program Requirements

- Teens must be at least 16 years of age by the first day of their selected session.
- Assistant Counselors will be expected to uphold all staff policies and procedures including behavioral expectations.
- AC's must plan to spend Thursday night at Camp Wabansi during their designated session(s). AC's will ride the bus to and from camp with the counselors during their session(s), as well.

Considerations

This program has limited openings. Applications will be considered through June 1 and must be complete upon submission. Previous Introductory Counselor (IC) or Junior Counselor (JC) experience at Camp Wabansi is preferred, but not required.

Candidates for this program will be interviewed by the Camp Director after their application has been reviewed. Interviews will be conducted over the phone.
