COVID Precautions at Camp Wabansi

At YMCA Camp Wabansi it is our responsibility to help maintain the health and safety of every guest we serve. Using resources from the CDC, ACA and State of Wisconsin we have developed a detailed document explaining how the Y staff at Camp Wabansi will provide a safe, healthy and quality program in the midst of the COVID pandemic. Although each element of the program has specific guidelines we urge families to familiarize themselves with these basic best practices that will be in place:

- Temperatures and a health screening will be taken of all guests upon arrival and daily for staff.
- Guests, campers and staff should wash or sanitize their hands before and after every activity.
- All equipment and supplies will be sanitized before and after every use.
- Campers and staff will maintain social distance whenever possible.
- Campers and staff must wear masks when entering any building and when within 6 ft. of others outside of designated cabin group.
- Restrooms will be sanitized twice a day by camp staff.
- Tables will be assigned in the Pavilion to restrict intermingling of groups and will be placed at least six feet apart.
- All activities that can be conducted outside to maintain maximum distance will be.
- Whole camp activities will take place outside with plenty of fresh air and distance.
- Campers will have assigned seats on the bus daily, bus capacity is restricted to 33 campers per bus with distance in between. Busses are deep cleaned/sanitized between each ride.
- Staff will monitor themselves and campers daily for symptoms of COVID and will immediately contact home if symptoms are present.
- There will be no Thursday night overnight for 2021 to reduce prolonged, unmasked exposure indoors.
- Families should bring any concerns to Y staff immediately.

Families and camp staff will need to work together to help ensure everyone has a safe, healthy and enjoyable time at Camp.



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If your family has an exposure to COVID we ask that you contact us immediately. We will rebook your camper for another session after they have quarantined for 10 days. You may choose to receive a refund instead, minus the non-refundable deposit.

If we have to cancel your session of camp due to COVID, we will issue a full refund for your camp fees.
